// UP-SKILL AND GET THE EDGE

The Short Courses program provides funding to assist with up-skilling and cross skilling existing workers in the building and construction industry. The training focuses on the safety, regulatory and licensing requirements of the industry and can provide you with a range of competencies that employers need; and as the program name suggests, our Short Courses are designed to get you up-skilled fast. All training must be completed by 30 September 2016.

// ELIGIBILITY

The student must be an existing worker; that is a current employee in the building and construction industry, who has a one month or more employment relationship with their employer. The working relationship can be built up through full-time, part-time or casual employment or engagement as a contract worker.

In addition the student must:

- be an Australian or New Zealand citizen; or; a permanent resident of Australia; or a refugee and humanitarian visa holder; and
- permanently reside in Queensland; or be permanently employed in Queensland; and must not be
- an employee of any Authority; or currently enrolled and participating in a Queensland secondary school program; a contracted trainer or assessor or existing worker of a Registered Training Organisation; previously funded under this program in the same contract term; funded by an Authority or such other source for delivery of the same training being undertaken as part of this program; those participants seeking a Verification of Competency (or Determination of competency); or other individuals that do not meet participant eligibility requirements.

// DOCUMENTATION RECORDING THE ELIGIBILITY OF PARTICIPANTS

CSQ requires that the following documentation be collected on enrolment. These documents will be retained by Civil Train for the duration of the contract term and for an additional period of six years.

- A copy of one of the following: birth certificate; passport; or visa; and
- a copy of one of the following: Queensland drivers license; a telephone account; a bank statement; a statement from a real estate agent; or any other formal documentation stating the student's full name and current residential address; and
- evidence of employment status and occupation: for example, a letter from the employer



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
